## Getting Started for TACs: CJIS Online and nexTEST Security Awareness Training

NCSBI has purchased **two programs** to provide agencies with electronic recordkeeping for Security Awareness Training instead of maintaining multiple paper lists for audit review. DCI Users will use **nexTest**. Non-users, agency IT, vendors and personnel receiving or having access to criminal justice information will use **CJIS Online**.

- 1. Go to <a href="https://evolve.ncdci.gov/">https://evolve.ncdci.gov/</a>
  - VPN is not required for any of the Security Awareness Training programs.
- Select CJIS Training for instruction manuals on nexTEST & CJIS Online.
  Programs offer 'Help' options on all screens. Training for these systems is self-guided.



3. DCI Certified Users will select *nexTEST* for Security Awareness Training



- 4. <u>Agency non-users, agency IT, vendors and any other personnel receiving or having access to criminal justice information</u> will select *CJIS Online*.
  - CJIS Online will allow TACs to set-up/check agency non-users, agency IT, vendors and any other personnel receiving or having access to criminal justice information.



5. Follow instruction manual to sign in to *nexTEST* & *CJIS Online*. Your sign in password will be <u>NCtempPASSWD1</u>.

Note: A test is now mandatory after completing Security Awareness Training.

\*\*As of <u>January 1, 2017</u> it is mandatory that agencies begin implementing these programs as employees/vendors are due for Security Awareness Training (within six months of initial assignment and every 2 years thereafter).\*\*
